20 YEARS AGO IN THE FLYER (from the June 2004 meeting recap)

Bill Setzler brought a spectacular, in-the-bones, ½-scale (14-ft wingspan) Pietenpol. Bill described how he manufactured many of the components for the scratch-built project started over a year ago, including built-up ribs with scale gussets and nails, replica 4-banger in-line engine constructed from wood, replica radiator from junk-yard parts, home-made metal hardware (control horns, hinges, etc.), "antique" wheels purchased from Bike Doctor, and struts made from aluminum tubing and formed to the correct streamline cross section in a wood press. Bill related the sometimesuncomfortable process of securing a ½-scale pilot for the aircraft - engaging a doll maker in western Maryland for the human form, and purchasing clothes for it in the children's department at Sears. The completed craft will

be powered by a Sachs 5.8 gas engine, and will weigh in the neighborhood of 75 lbs.
